WAYLAND CITY CURBSIDE RECYCLING NEWS

This is a reminder that city residents have access to the **Curbside Recycling Program** offered through Wayland City. Residents can sign up to receive a recycling cart by contacting the recycling coordinator at 269-686-4559 or residents can sign up by visiting the City Hall.

(*This program is funded through a residential \$25 annual surcharge on tax bill.)

“The average American produces 4-6 pounds of garbage per day. Half of this can be recycled.”

Curbside Recycling Materials:

The following items are acceptable to place together in the recycling cart:

- metal cans,
- plastic bottles or jugs with recycling numbers #1-#7,
- plastic bags #2 & #4,
- paper, cardboard, magazines and newspaper.

Make sure ***all*** items are **clean** and cardboard is broken down inside cart.

2017 Curbside Pick Up Dates

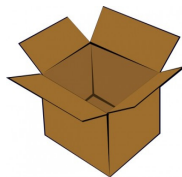
All homes in the city will be serviced biweekly on **Fridays**. Place carts out the evening prior to collection day.

Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)

Residents in the city have access to great additional recycling services. For many years the **Allegan County Health Department (ACHD)** has collected Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) by appointment.

ACHD contracts to collect, sort and properly dispose of HHW, making this a great way to properly dispose of harmful chemicals such as the following items listed...

Resource Recovery Cards - Salem Township Recycle Station

Your Resource Recovery Card allows you to recycle tires (4 per year), Styrofoam, appliances (2 per year) (stoves, microwaves, dishwasher, refrigerator), TV (1 per year)/computer/electronic items) and scrap metal recycling. These types of materials can be taken to the **Salem Twp.**

Transfer Station located at 4145 29th Street, Dorr, MI.



Resource Recovery Cards are available at the City Hall. This station is open on the 1st and 3rd Saturdays of the month between 8:30am-3:30 pm. (Closed Jan & Feb.)

Trash Service is available for a fee.

Allegan County hosts several regional recycling and proper disposal events. These events include: Household Hazardous Waste Collections, Unwanted Medication Collections and TV/ Computer/ Electronic Device Collections.
