ANNUAL SPRING CLEAN-UP & BULK TRASH PICKUP

 **Spring Clean-Up Dates 2026:** Monday, May 4th- West side of Main St. Tuesday, May 5th East side of Main St.

Help keep our community clean! During Spring Clean-Up Week, DPW crews will collect **large household items that do not fit in your regular weekly trash service.**


IMPORTANT PICKUP RULES

-  All items must be placed at the curb by 7:00 AM on your scheduled pickup day.
 -  Crews will make ONE pass only on each street.
 -  Once crews have completed the route, they will NOT return for additional pickup.
 -  Crews are not allowed to remove items from trailers.

WHAT IS BULK TRASH?

Bulk trash pickup is for **LARGE ITEMS ONLY** that do not fit in your regular weekly pickup.

 Smaller items that fit in a garbage bag should be disposed of with your regular trash pickup — NOT bulk pickup.


















 **Pickup Limit: 3 cubic yards per dwelling unit**
(Approximately equal to one pickup truck bed)

✓ ACCEPTED ITEMS

-  Furniture (couches, chairs, tables)
 -  Mattresses & box springs
 -  Large toys / play equipment
 -  Carpet (cut, rolled & tied)
 -  Scrap metal items
 -  Grills **without propane tanks**
 -  Small amounts of remodeling debris (*within volume limit*)

✗ NOT ACCEPTED

(Restricted or banned from Michigan landfills)

-  Broken concrete or masonry
 -  Appliances of any kind (washers, dryers, refrigerators, stoves, etc.)
 -  Iron fence posts or heavy metal posts
 -  Grass clippings or yard waste
 -  Leaves
 -  Any item weighing more than 60lbs
 -  Items not boxed or bagged appropriately
 -  Bagged household trash
 -  Electronics (TVs, computers, monitors)
 -  Tires
 -  Car batteries
 -  Paint, chemicals, or hazardous materials
 -  Motor oil or automotive fluids
 -  Fluorescent or mercury bulbs
 -  Medical waste or sharps
 -  Asbestos materials
 -  Windows or Glass
